

WHY WE ARE



Because of Ezra is a non-profit organization which raises awareness and funding to combat pediatric solid mass cancers. Ezra Matthews was diagnosed with stage 4 neuroblastoma on October 4th, 2009 at the age of 13 months. After chemo, radiation, and other treatment, on April Fools Day, 2010 Ezra had his neuroblastoma tumor successfully removed - then went into 30 days of stem cell transplant. The day before Ezra's 2nd birthday (August of 2010) it was discovered he'd relapsed already, less than 4 months out of stem cell transplant. This meant his neuroblastoma was very aggressive, and there was **no current cure**.



On November 8th, at 2:50am, Ezra passed on. The neuroblastoma had kept growing, and although they did one last round of chemo in Orlando, it didn't stop, and early on a Monday morning his parents Kyle and Robyn lay in his bed with him and held him as he died.

Children just like Ezra are diagnosed with neuroblastoma (the most common cancer in infants) and other solid-mass pediatric cancers *every day*. Survival numbers for stage 4 (which over 2/3 of kids are diagnosed with) are only 30-40%. We seek to fill some of the large gaps in pediatric cancer research funding and focus on these solid-mass cancers. Our focus is a cure - we advocate for and fund relevant, patient-affecting research. This innovative work is directly affecting families facing neuroblastoma.

Because of Ezra partners with various researchers, physicians, and scientists who fit our goal of making a difference in survival today. With your help from 2011-13 we've been able to give nearly \$300,000 to innovative research across the globe. We look specifically at doctors and teams who are directly dealing with patient-affecting treatment options for solid-mass pediatric cancer. Over 90% of your donations go directly to research and awareness.

Take a look at what your financial help can do:

- \$50 One hour of clinical research
- \$75 Clinic visit for a child with cancer
- \$100 Support a child in a hospital for a day
- \$250 One day of laboratory research
- \$500 Create patient specific tumor model in laboratory for testing
- \$750 Initial test of a new drug therapy in the laboratory
- \$1,000 Genetic screen of child's tumor to identify therapies
- \$1,500 Support one family trip to travel for cancer treatment
- \$2,500 Allow one child to start on a clinical trial, providing drug and hope to a family
- \$4,000 Sequence DNA of a child's tumor
- \$5,000 Open a new clinical trial at one hospital in the US providing children in a new community with access to therapy

You can help. Although **cancer is the number one disease killer of children in the US, and the 2nd overall killer** (behind car accidents), we aren't talking about it enough. There isn't enough funding for research and clinical trials. We need your help to raise awareness and funding. We can't say enough how thankful we are for people like you who give of their time, talent, finances, and relationships to help this battle move forward.

We can beat this.
